## EITREP COVERING PERIOD 260600B JAN TO 270600B JAN 94.

# I. GEN SITUATION, FOILOWING INCIDENT TOOK PLACE ON 26 JAN 94:

- A. A PATROL OF KIBAT WAS SECT AT ARCUND 22.00 HRS, NUT FAR FROM FORCE HQ (400 M). IT HAPPENED WHEN THE PATROL ARRIVED AT A ROAD BLOCK ESTABLISHED BY SOME LOOTERS. THEY DID NOT RESPOND THE FIRE AND NO TRACE OF THE SHOTS WERE FOUND ON THE VEHICLES. THE PATROL WAS ABLE TO CATCH ONE MAN WITHOUT A GUN; HE WAS BROUGHT TO THE GENDARMERIE BRIGADE FOR PURTHER INVESTIGATIONS. CIVEGE WILL HAMPLE THE FOLLOW UP.
- B. TWO DEAD BODIES NERE BROUGHT DURING THE NIGHT TO KIGALI HOSPITAL, ONE BY UNAMIE, ONE BY LOCAL PEOPLE. BOTH DEATHS WERE CAUSED BY BEATING WITH MACHETES AND BATONS.
- C. THERE WERE ALSO SOME CASUALTIES IN CITY CENTRE AFTER FIGHTINGS (POLITICAL OR ETHNICAL IS NOT ESTABLISHED AS YET). ONE WOMAN AND TWO MEN WERE ALSO REPORTED TO KIGALI HOSPITAL WITH KNIFE AND BATON WOUNDS AT HEAD AND UPPER BODY PARTS.
- D. CIVPOL IS FOLLOWING UP THE GENDARMERIE INVESTIGATIONS IN THIS MATTER.
- E. KIBAT EXECUTED INTENSIVE FOOT PTL IN THE TROUBLE AREA OF 26 JAN, ACCOMPANIED BY GENDARMERIE, THIS PATROLS WILL CONTINUE TODAY.

RWANDESE RADIO GAVE A RELEASE ABOUT THE INCIDENTS OF YESTERDAY, THEY SAID THAT THERE WERE THREE CASUALTIES DUE TO THE RPF FIRING. IN THE INTERVIEW GIVEN BY FC TO RWANDESE MEDIA YESTERDAY AFTERNOON, THIS WAS DENIED FIRMLY. RADIO RWANDA PROUGHT THIS INTERVIEW IMMEDIATELY AFTER THEIR RELEASE OF THE CASUALTIES. THE SITUATION IN KIGALI IS GETTING TENSER BECAUSE OF KILLING PEOPLE, FIRING INCIDENTS AND CREATION OF ROAD BLOCKS. IT IS BELEIVED THAT BANDITRY IS ON THE RISE.

## II. PACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

AT 10.00 HRS SRSG MET WITH M. KABA POLITICAL . IBRAHIM, REPRESENTATIVE OF PAO, AT UNAMIR HQ. AND AT 12.00 HRS HE MET WITH COLONEL ALEXIS KANYARENGWE, CHAIRMAN OF RPF AT THE CND. AT 15.00 HRS SESS VISITED A DISPLACED PERSONS CAMP AT NYACYONGA. THE AIM WAS TO REMIND THESE PEOPLE OF THE DANGERS OF GOING BACK TOO SOON AND ALSO TO LET THE REALIZE THE HUMANITARIAN LEADERSHIP POLITICAL INTERNATIONAL RESPONSABILITIES. NATIONAL LARGE REPRESENTED, THE VERY LARGE CROWD WAS FRIENDLY, ATTENTIVE AND INQUISITIVE: THEY HOPED THEIR POLITICIANS WOULD DO THE SAME. HE RETURNED TO KIGALI AT 17.00 HRS.

#### III. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. HOS. AT 08.00 HRS FC HE'LL A MEETING WITH UNDER ON THE ISSUE OF THE RWANDAN REFUGEES COMING BACK FROM UGANDA TO RWANDA AND ON DEMOBILIZATION MANDATE AND FUNDING. FC HELD MEETING WITH ALL SEC COMMANDERS FOR INVESTIGATION AND CONSULTATION ON THE INCIDENT THAT TOOK FLACE NEAR CND COMPLEX IN THE MORNING. AT 20.35 HFS FC ALSO HANDED OVER A LETTER OF PROTEST TO THE CHAIFMAN OF FRF CONCERNING THE VIOLATION OF KWSA RULES AND THE OVERREACTION TO THE DEMONSTRATION BY THE RPF BN COP AND THE RPF SEMIOR LN OFFR.

## B. SECTORS.

- (1) KIGALI. AT 19.90 HRS COMD SEC KIGALI HAD A MEETING WITH THE RPF BN COMD. THEY HAD DISCUSSION ON THE INCIDENT TOOK PLACE IN AND AROUND THE CND COMPLEX. CONDUCTED VEHICLE AND FOOT PTL IN KIGALI CITY IN ORDER TO ENSURE KIGALI WEAPON SECURE AREA. ESTABLISHED 2 CHECK POINTS AT DIFFERENT PLACES IN KWSA. PROVIDED 2 UNMO ESCORTS TO GENDARMFPIE, 2 FOR RPF, 3 FOR UNAMIR. ALSO PROVIDED ARMED ESCORTS FOR PRIME MINISTER, RPF AND 2 FOR TANZANIA. SECURED THE LOCATION OF THE RPF BATTALION IN KIGALI CITY, THE PREMATURE, FORCE HQ AND SEC HQ AND PROVIDED SECURITY TO THE AIRPORT OF KIGALI. DURING THE NIGHT ASSURED PROTECTION FOR THE PRIME MINISTER, THE PRIME MINISTER DESIGNATE, THE PRESIDENT OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT AND FIVE OPPOSITION MINISTERS, AND TO THE RESIDENCE OF SRSG.
- (2) DMZ. CONDUCTED SPECIAL PTL TO NATIONAL PARK (A6441) TO VERTEY REFORT REGARDING OCCUPYING A POSITION IN KINIGI BY RGF. PTG DID NOT FOUND ANY RGF AT THAT PLACE, IT IS SUSPECTED THAT INFORMER MIGHT HAVE MISTAKEN FOREST GUARDS FOR FSF. BECAUSE GUARDS WEAR THE SAME UNIFORM LIFE ROF SOLDIERS. EXCEPT THE HEAD GEAR, ALSO CONDUCTED PTG PROM RUHENGERI, KIDAHO, KAGOGO, PTL FOUND 7 CIVILIANS WERE LOCKED UP IN THE KIDAHO COMMUNAL OFFICE. HEY WERE ALLAGED TO HAVE STOLEN THE DOORS AND WINDOWS OF THE OFFICE. RUHENGERI PUBLIC PROSECUTOR WAS INFORMED AND DMZ SEC WILL ESCORT ONE JUDICIAN INSPECTOR TO KEDAHO ON 27 JAN 94 TO INVESTIGATE THE CACE. ALSO ESCOPTED PERSONNEL OF THE INTERNATIONAL ACCOCIATION AMAINST HUNGER TO KINIGI. CARRIED OUT ROUTINE FTI FROM RUHENGERI, KALINGGRERA, KIRAMBO (A8235) PHEPERERE (A8535) MUSHONGIO (A9018). PET BECCUERED THE PART CREATED AT THE INTERNAL (AUDRESS)

AND HANDED OVER TO HIMOS, ALSO MONITORED TORC FOOD DISTRIBUTION AT NYAMIGALI. CONDUCTED FTL FROM BYUMBA TO KISSARO AND MILIYOVI. THRISEAN DETACHMENTS PROVIDED SECURITY FOR A JOINT MERGING AT NGONDORE ATTENDED BY REP OF RPF, RFF AND GRAMIR.

- C. MILOB. AN ESCORT TEAM SENT TO RUSUMO (TANZANIAN BORDER) FOR ESCORT OF AFCATRICK CONVOY FROM DARESSALAM. A RECCE PTL CONDUCTED ARDITO FWEA TO VARIFY RGF BUILD UP. UNMOS TEAM ARE SENT IN EPF ZONE FOR FAMILIARIZATION.
- UNOMUR. THE SITUATION IN THE UNOMUR AREA IS CALM. ON 25 JAN 94 RPF WAS SHOOTING SINGLE ROUND OF SMALL ARM FIRE (7.62MM) AT THEIR POST OFPOSITE OF KATUNA GRID RJ 024416. THE SHOOTING CONTINUED FROM 250750 TO 250820 JAN 94. THE CMO CONDUCTED PLATFOR MEETING WITH THE DA AND BRIGADE COMD IN KARALE, FROM KATUNA IT WAS REPORTED ONE TRUCK NUMBER PLATE UPB 717 ARRIVED AT THE CROSSING POINT, WHEN THE MILORS STARTED CHECKING THE VEHICLE, THREE (3) OF THE FIVE (5) PASSENGERS SUDDENLY BUN AWAY TOWARDS THE BORDER AND CROSSED TO RWANDA. THE VEHICLE WAS CARRYING MAIZE, BEAMS AND COWS. THE DRIVER OF THE TRUCK LATER ON ALSO CROSSED THE BORDER TO RWANDA (RPF SIDE) TO SLEEP LEAVING HIS TRUCK AT CP3 FOR THE SUBSEQUENT DEF LOADING AND CHECKS. ONE PTL FOUND UNEXPLODED HAND/AND RIFLE GRENADES AT VUGAMBA RANGE IN THE SURFOUNDING OF BOUNDARY PILLAR NO. 12 (RJ 7025240. NINE (3) VEHICLES OF THE ICRC CROSSED THE BORDER PROM LIGANDA TO RWANDA. THE PLAN FOOTBALL MATCH WITH THE KABALE POLICE ON 26 SAN 94 CANCELLED BY THE POLICE. A TOTAL OF THIRTREN (13) VEHICLES GROSSED THE BORDER AT KATUNA. ELEVEN (11) GOING FROM UGAUDA TO RWANDA TWO (2) VEHICLES GOING FROM RWANDA TO UGANDA THE VEHICLES WERE CAPRYING PASSENGERS AND PERSONAL LUGGAGE. NOTHING SIGNIFICANT WAS FOUND.
