- 1. GEN SITUATION: THE SITUATION OBSERVED TO BE TENSE AFTER A FOURTH UNSUCCESSFUL ATTEMPT ON 25 MAR 94 TO INSTALL THE BROAD BASED TRANSITIONAL GOVERNMENT AND THE TRANSITIONAL NATIONAL ASSEMBLY.
- 2. FOLITICAL ACTIVITIES. BROAD BASED TRANSITIONAL GOVERNMENT NOT YET INSTALLED. NEGOTIATIONS ONGOING.

  - (1) ON 261500 MAR 94, THERE WAS A FIGHT AMONGST LOCALS IN FRONT OF THE CND COMPLEX. AS A RESULT A YOUNG MAN HAD MAJOR INJURIES AND HE REPORTED TO THE RPF GATE.
