SITREP COVERING PERIOD 240600B APR TO 250600B APR 94.

- QEN_SITUATION. SITUATION STILL TENSE AND VOLATILE, MORNING OF PERIOD WAS RELATIVELY CALM. HOWEVER INTENSIVE SHELLING OF CND COMPLEX STARTED JUST BEFORE NOON AND LASTED FOR ABOUT AN HOUR. EXCHANGES CONTINUED LATE NIGHT FOR ABOUT THREE HOURS. THERE WERE NO CHANGES IN THE FORWARD EDGE OF BATTLE AREA IN THE NORTH AND EAST OF COUNTRY. MASSACRE OF CIVILIANS STILL GOING ON IN AND AROUND BUTARE IN THE SOUTH. NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN AREAS HELD BY WARRING FACTIONS WITHIN THE CITY. EXODUS OF REPUGEES FROM AMAHORO STADIUM, KING FAISAL HOSPITAL HEADING NORTH VIA THE VALLEYS NORTH OF CITY OBSERVED DURING THE MORTH. HUMANITARIAN CELL MET AND VISITED REFUGEE CAMPS TO ASSESS SITUATION AND THE IMMEDIATE NEEDS OF REFUGEES, FC RETURNED FROM BYUMBA AFTER HOLDING DISCUSSIONS WITH MAJ GEN KAGAME.
- 2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES: STALEMATE CONTINUES. NOTHING SIGNIFICANT TO REPORT.

3. PACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

- A. RPF. OBSERVED MOVING TROOPS AND ARTY/MORTAR WEADONS OUT OF CND COMPLEX OVERNIGHT TO UNKNOWN LOCATIONS. INFILTRATIONS INTO CITY CONTINUE. DID NOT CONDUCT ANY SERIOUS FIGHTING IN CITY DURING PERIOD. APPEARED TO HAVE HEEN SLIGHTLY PUSHED BACK IN THE AREA AROUND THE AMAHORO STADIUM. HIGH COMMAND WARNED UNAMIR HQ OF IMMINENT ATTACK IN CITY FROM NIGHT 24/25 APR 94 TILL ON OR ABOUT 26 APR 94.
- B. RGF. TROOPS OBSERVED ABOUT 300M BAST OF AMAHORO STADIUM. NO OTHER SIGNIFICANT CHANGE OBSERVED IN CITY AND REST OF COUNTRY.
- 4. ONE MILITARY ACTIVITIES TROOPS SETTLING INTO NEW TASKS AND IMPROVING OWN DEFENSES.
 - A. FORCE HQ. FC RETURNED FROM MULINDI AND HELD MORNING AMD EVENING BRIEFINGS AT 240930 AND 242000 RESPECTIVELY. THERE WERE TWO ALARM SCHEME REHEARSALS DURING THE PERIOD. IMPROVEMENT OF DEFENERS AROUND HQ STILL IN PROGRESS, REFPORTS BEING HAMPERED BY SPORADIC FIRE DIRECTED AT TROOPS DOING THE WORK. IMPROVEMENTS CONTINUE TODAY. SECURITY OF HQ PROVIDED BY GHANA PLATOON AND 4 X APCS MANNED BY TUNISIANS. HUMANITARIAN CELL NOW INTEGRATED INTO FORCE HQ.
