- THE FIRST HALF OF THE DAY OBSERVED TO BE CALM. HOWEVER HOSTILITY BROKE OUT AROUND NOON AND CONTINUED TILL LATE AFTERNOON AROUND THE CITY CENTER FEW MORTAR SHELLS LANDED AROUND HOTEL MILLIE COLLINES, NO CASUALTIES REPORTED. A SHELL LANDED AT AMAHORO STADIUM ON 021955 MAY 94. TWO REFUGEES WERE INJURED. RPF SEEMS TO BE TIGHTENING THEIR GRIP IN THE CITY. RGF STILL PUTTING RESISTANCE IN SOME AREAS, ESPECIALLY IN THE CITY. NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN THE DISPOSITION OF BOTH THE WARRING GROUPS IN THE CITY. MILITIA CONTINUE TO HOLD CITY CENTER AND ARBA AROUND NYAMIRAMEO.
- 2. SEVEN REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE CANADIAN MEDIA HAVE ARRIVED AT KIGALI THIS MORNING. THEY WILL VISIT UNAMIR AND REFUGEE CAMPS LOCATED AT KIGALI FROM 2 MAY TO 4 MAY 94.
- 3. TODAY FC SPENT A VERY BUSY DAY. THIS MORNING FC HAD A MEETING WITH THE COS OF RGF AT RGF HQ, FC GAVE AN INTERVIEW TO THE CANADIAN JOURNALIST TEAM AT UNAMIR FORCE HQ. HE ALSO GAVE ANOTHER INTERVIEW TO RTLM AT HOTEL DIPLOMATE. FC HAD A CONFERENCE WITH THE COMMANDERS AND PROS. SREG AND DEC LEFT KIGALI FOR NAIROBI FOR ONWARD MOVE TO TANZANIA IN ORDER TO ATTEND THE PEACE TALK WHICH IS SCHEDULED TO TAKE PLACE AT ARUSHA ON 63 MAY 94.
- 4. HAC CONTINUED PATROLLING TO THE DISPLACED PERSONS CAMP AT KIGALI. THE ICRC DELIVERED MEDICAL SUPPLIES AND PROVIDED TREATMENT TO THE WOUNDED PERSONS OF SAINTE FAMILLE CAMP. HA ADVANCE TEAM

DELIVERED TWO BASIC HEALTH KITS TO THE KING FAISAL HOSPITAL AND ALSO DELIVERED 12 BOXES OF HIGH ENERGY BISCUITS (HEB) TO THE HOTEL MERIDIEN. HAC HAVE EVACUATED 11 EXPATRIATES FROM KIGALI TO NAIROBI.
