- THE GEN SITUATION IS VERY TENSE AND FLUID. INTENSIVE FIRING AND SHELLING CONTINUED THROUGH OUT THE DAY. TODAY THE BATTLE AREA SPREADED INTO THE VARIOUS PARTS OF THE KIGALI CITY. RPF SHELLED AROUND HOTEL MILLIE COLLINS, MIN OF DEF AND DOWN TOWN KIGALI. RGF ALSO RETALIATED AND FIRED ARTY SHELLS DIRECTLY TO THE CND BUILDING. RPF CONTINUED TIGHTENING THEIR GRIP IN THE CITY. RGF PUTTING UP SOME RESISTANCE IN VARIOUS AREAS OF THE KIGALI CITY. HOWEVER NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN THE DISPOSITION OF BOTH THE WARRING GROUPS IN THE CITY. MILITIA STILL HOLDING SOME AREAS IN THE TOWN UNDER THEIR CONTROL. AT 0941 HRS ONE OF THE PACTION FIRED DIRECTLY WITH SMALL ARMS TO THE UN MILITARY AIRCRAFT WHICH WAS STATIONED AT THE RUNNAY, UNAMIR LODGED A STRONG PROTEST TO BOTH THE FACTIONS, RPF STILL TRYING TO BREAK THROUGH THE RGF POSITION IN RUHENGERI AND MKUMBA, HEAVY EXCHANGE OF ARTY AND MORTAR FIRE CONTINUED IN THAT ARRA.
- FC HELD A CONF WITH HIS COMMANDERS AND PSOS AT PORCE HQ. FC MET COS RGF IN THE EVENING. FC STATED THAT SOME GROUP IS TARGETING UNAMIR INSTALLATIONS AT THE AIRFORT. COS RGF HAVE ASSURED FC THAT THIS TYPE OF INCIDENTS WOULD NOT BE REPEATED FROM HIS SIDE. THEY ALSO DISCUSSED ABOUT THE FUTURE OF UNAMIR MISSION, COS RGF RE-STATED THAT UNAMIR MISSION HAD TO STAY TO BRING PRACE IN THIS COUNTRY.
- HAC CONTINUED PATROLLING WITH UNNOS AT VARIOUS DISPLACED PERSON CAMPS IN KIGALI. AN AGREEMENT WAS FORWARDED TO THE COS OF

RGF AND RPF FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF A SECURE MEANS TO EXCHANGE DISPLACED PERSONS TO THE AREAS OF THEIR OWN CHOICE. ANOTHER MEETING WAS HELD BETWERN THE HAC, RGF AND REPRESENTATIVE OF LOCAL MILITIAS. ICRC DELIVERED FOOD SUPPLIES TO TWO ORPHANAGES GIZINBA AND MARC MOTHER. A CONVOY MOVED FROM BUJUNBURA TO KABGAYI TO SET UP A FD HOSPITAL IN THE CONVENT AT KABGYI. HA THAM DELIVERED HEALTH KIT TO AMAHORO STADIUM.
