- 1. GEN SITUATION. SITUATION REMAINS TENSE AND FLUID. BOTH SIDES CONTINUE TO EXCHANGE FIRE IN THE NORTH (AROUND CYBRU, NKUMBA AND RUHENGERI) AND IN THE SOUTH (AROUND BUGESBRA). FIRE WAS ALSO EXCHANGED ALL NIGHT IN THE CITY IN THE AREAS OF REMBRA KICHYCIRU AND KIMIHIRURA. NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN LINES HELD BY BOTH SIDES IN THE CITY.
