SITREP COVERING PERIOD 180608B HAY TO 181800B HAY 94.

- 1. GEN SITUATION: NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGE IN THE GENERAL SITUATION. THE FIRST HALF OF THE DAY WAS RELATIVELY CALM. HOWEVER EXCHANGE OF ARTY/MOR AND SA FIRING BETWEEN RPF AND RGF CONTINUED FROM MID DAY. THE MAJOR BATTLE AREAS WERE KICHIKIRO, REMERA AND KANOMBE. FIGHTING BETWEEN RPF AND RGF REPORTED FROM RUHENGERI IN THE NORTH. BUGESERA IS STILL CONTROLLED BY RPF IN THE SOUTH. NO CHANGE IN THE POSITION BEING HELD BY EOTH THE FACTIONS IN CITY. MILITIA ONLY HOLDING NYAMIRAMBO AREA IN KIGALI CITY.
- 2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. NTR.
- 3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.
 - A. RPF. RPF SHELLED AT CAMP KANOMBE, AND DOWN TOWN AFTER MID DAY, A FEW SHELLS LANDED AROUND HOTEL MILLIE COLLINS. THEY ARE ALSO HOLDING CAMP KANOMBE UNDER DIRECT FIRE FROM HIGH GROUND AROUND THE CAMP MOUNT JERRI IS NOW UNDER RPF CONTROL.
 - B. RGE. ADOPTING A DEFENSIVE POSTURE AND CONSOLIDATING POSITIONS HELD IN THE CITY. RGF STILL CONTROLLING RUHENGERI AND NAUMBA AND HARASSING RPF POSITIONS. INFORMATION REVEALED THAT RGF HAVE TRAINED 10,000 YOUNG PERSONS MAINLY PROM CDR POLITICAL GROUP.

- A. FORCE HQ: NORMAL ROUTINE WORKS WERE CONDUCTED. CARRIED OUT PATROLLING IN CITY AREA. FC HELD NORMAL BRIEFING WITH COMMANDER: AND STAFFS AT 180700. FC GAVE AN INTERVIEW TO A GROUP OF JOURNALISTS AT FORCE HQ. AT 0900 HRS FC HELD A MEETING WITH COS RGF AT HOTEL DIPLOMAT. FC ALSO MET MINISTER OF DEPENCE AT 1055 HRS. THE PATROL TEAM OBSERVED TOO MANY CASES OF SICKNESS IN ALL THE CAMPS. ICRC DELIVERED 15 TONS OF ALUMINUM SULPHATE TO KIGALI WATER TREATMENT PLANT WITH AN UNDERSTANDING THAT RGF WILL SUPPLY WATER TO THE ENTIRE CITY. ICRC MEDICAL TEAM ALSO VISITED GITEGA AND GISIMBA ORPHANAGES. HA THAM DELIVERED 122 BOXES OF HEB AND 15 BAGS OF BEANS TO THE GITEGA ORPHANAGE, 50 BOXES OF HEB AND 10 BAGS OF BEANS TO THE GIEIMBA ORPHANAGE.
