- NERE NO EXCHANGE OF FIRE BETWEEN THE TWO FACTIONS IN KIGALI. THERE NERE NO EXCHANGE OF FIRE BETWEEN THE TWO FACTIONS IN KIGALI CITY HOWIVER SOME SPORADIC FIRE WERE HEARD IN THE CUTSKIRTS OF THE CITY. AFTER THE WITHDRAWAL OF RGF TROOPS FROM THEIR POSITIONS IN KIGALI CITY IT IS NOW BELIEVED THAT KIGALI CITY IS UNDER FULL CONTROL OF RP?. SINCE RPF HAVE IMPOSED RESTRICTIONS ON UNMOS MOVE IN TO KIGALI CITY, SITUATION IN KIGALI IS NOT YET CLEAR TO US. IT IS ALSO REPORTED THAT RPF HAVE ALSO CAPTURED BUTARE IN THE SOUTH, THE NEW SREG HAS STARTED HIS ACTIVITIES WITH UNAMIR. HE WILL BE BRIEFED BY FC, CHIEF OF OPERATIONS, HAC AND OTHER BRANCH HEADS ON VARIOUS ASPECTS OF UNAMIR ACTIVITIES LATER THIS MORNING. THE NORMAL ESCORT CONVOY LEFT FOR KAGITUMBA THIS MORNING WITH PERSONNEL PROCREDING TO NAIROBI VIA ENTEBBE. DFC LEFT FOR NAIROBI FOR CHWARD MOVE TO GHAMA ON A SHORT LEAVE. A PLATOON FROM GHAMIAN BATTALION LEFT FOR UGANDA TO SSTABLISH A TRANSIT CAMP AT ENTABLES AIRPORT.
- 2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. THE SPONEDRM FROM THE FRENCH POREIGN MINISTER HAS STATED THAT OPERATION " TURQUISE" DID NOT NEED THE APPROVAL OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL TO ISTABLISE THE "SAFE HEAVER" AREAS IN THE WESTERN PART OF RHANDA. THOSE AREAS WILL BE ESTABLISHED: IN THE PRAMENORS OF THE RESOLUTION 918 OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES:

- A. BEE. IT IS NOW CLEAR THAT RIGALI IS NOW UNDER THE PULL CONTROL OF THE RPF. THE FORCES APPARENTLY TAKEN OVER THE CITY YESTERDAY AFTER DISLODGING THE RGF FROM THEIR REMAINING POSITIONS. INFORMATION ALSO REVEALED THAT RPF HAVE ALSO CAPTURED BUTARE IN THE SOUTH OF THE COUNTRY. REPORTS ARE CIRCULATING WIDELY OF RPF, S INTENTION TO ANNOUNCE A PROVISIONAL GOVERNMENT. HOWEVER THIS INFORMATION HAS NOT BEEN CONFIRMED OFFICIALLY BY THE RPF. NO CHANGES IN DISPOSITION AROUND RUHENGERI.
- B. EGE. AFTER THE FULL OUT OF TROOFS FROM THEIR POSITIONS IN KIGALI OVERNIGHT THEY ARE NOW REPORTED TO BE LOCATED AT 20 KMS NORTH OF KIGALI AND INTEND TO MOVE FURTHER NORTH TOWARDS RUBERGERI. THEIR INTENTION FOR THE PUTURE BATTLE IS NOT CLEAR AT THIS MOMENT AS UNAMIR COULD NOT ESTABLISH ANY CONTACT WITH THE RGF HILITARY COMMANDERS. NO CHANGES HAVE BEEN REPORTED IN THEIR DISPOSITIONS IN THE NORTH.
- C. MILITIA, ELEMENTS LEFT THE CITY OVERNIGHT AND MANY OF THEM ARE ARRESTED BY THE RPF.
