- 1. SUMMARY: UNHCR OGATA PRAISED THE GOT'S COOPERATION AND RESPONSE TO THE INFLUX OF RWANDAN REFUGEES. SHE EMPHASIZED THE IMPORTANCE OF CAMP SECURITY, BUT DEFENDED THE GOT'S HANDLING OF ACCUSED CRIMINALS SUCH AS GATETE.

- 2. (U) UNHCR SADAKO OGATA VISITED TANZANIA JULY 10-12 INCLUDING A ONE-DAY VISIT TO BENACO ON JULY 10. IN A BRIEFING WITH DIPLOMATS IN DAR ON JULY 11, SHE EXPRESSED SATISFACTION WITH THE OPERATION SO FAR NOTING THE GOOD FORTUNE TO HAVE HAD MATERIAL AND STAFF IN THE AREA FROM THE LAST YEAR'S BURUNDI OPERATION. SHE NOTED THAT THE FOOD SUPPLY WAS IN MUCH BETTER SHAPE BECAUSE OF LESSONS LEARNED FROM THE BURUNDI OPERATION.
- 3. (U) SHE APPEALED FOR DONOR ASSISTANCE IN PROTECTING AND RESTORING THE LOCAL ENVIRONMENT AND IN BUILDING UP THE LOCAL INFRASTRUCTURE. IN PARTICULAR, SHE THANKED THE BRITISH FOR THE TEMPORARY BRIDGE CONNECTING NGARA TOWN AND THE AIRSTRIP WITH THE BENACO CAMP. SHE APPEALED FOR ADDITIONAL HELP WITH THE LOCAL INFRASTRUCTURE SUCH AS PAVING THE AIRSTRIP AT NGARA AND CONFIDENTIAL

PAGE 03 DAR ES 04372 01 OF 02 121359Z IMPROVING THE ROAD NETWORK THROUGHOUT THE REGION. SHE ALSO NOTED ENVIRONMENTAL DAMAGE CAUSED BY THE REFUGEES. WHILE SHE WAS AT BENACO SHE MARKED TREES WHICH REFUGEES WERE NOT TO CUT.

- 4. (U) MRS. OGATA SAID THAT THE MOST IMPORTANT ISSUE NOW IS SECURITY. SHE EXPLAINED THAT THERE WERE NOT ENOUGH POLICEMEN FOR BENACO. UNHOR TANZANIA REP KOLUDE DOHERTY ELABORATED THAT THE 200-300 EXTRA POLICEMEN (REF A) FROM BUKOBA AND MWANZA WILL NOT ARRIVE UNTIL NEXT WEEK. THE UNHOR HAS AGREED TO SUPPLY THE TANZANIAN POLICE WITH BASIC EQUIPMENT, HOUSING, AND AN EXTRA ALLOWANCE FOR BEING POSTED AWAY FROM HOME.
- 5. (U) DOHERTY EXPLAINED THAT THE GOT TASK FORCE STUDYING THE BROADER ISSUES OF BORDER AND CAMP SECURITY WOULD HAVE ITS REPORT READY NEXT MONTH (AND NOT THIS WEEK AS EARLIER PROMISED TO POST BY FOMIN PERMSEC). THE MOST EFFECTIVE, LONG-TERM SECURITY MEASURE WILL BE THE PROCESS OF 'DECONGESTING' BENACO. UNHCR HAS ALREADY LOCATED 40,000 REFUGEES OUT OF BENACO TO LUMASI

CAMP AND IS SEARCHING FOR SITES TO RELOCATE AT LEAST ANOTHER 90,000. (ONE SITE CONSIDERED PRIME BY THE UNHOR BUT TOO CLOSE TO BENACO BY SOME OF THE NGO'S IS LEASED TO A CONSORTIUM OF NICKEL MINING FIRMS. THE CONSORTIUM IS ONLY IN THE EXPLORATORY STAGE BUT FEARS THAT THE REFUGEES PRESENCE ON ITS CONCESSION WOULD BE CONFIDENTIAL

(U) AFTER OGATA'S BRIEFING TO THE DIPLOMATS, AMERICAN CHARGE ASKED HER TO EXPLAIN THE UNHOR'S POSITION ON RWANDAN REFUGEE LEADER AND ACCUSED MURDERER GATETE. OGATA, WHO OBVIOUSLY HAD BEEN PREPPED FOR THE QUESTION BY DOHERTY, REPLIED THAT THE UN HAD AN OBLIGATION TO SET UP A MECHANISM TO BRING CRIMINALS TO JUSTICE. THIS PROCESS HAD ALREADY BEGUN. IN ADDITION TO THE EFFORTS OF THE UN SPECIAL RAPPARTEUR, THE UNSC HAS CALLED FOR A COMMITTEE OF EXPERTS TO STUDY POSSIBLE VIOLATIONS OF THE GENOCIDE CONVENTION. THE ROLE OF THE UNHCR, HOWEVER, IS TO CARE FOR REFUGEES AND THEY ARE FULFILLING THAT RESPONSIBLITY AS RAPIDLY AND EFFECTIVELY AS POSSIBLE. OGATA SAID THE UNHOR WAS AWARE THAT GATETE HAD LEFT BENACO, BUT HAD NO FURTHER INFORMATION CONCERNING HIS PLANS. SHE DEFENDED
