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SUSPEND FOREIGN AID TO UGANDA

On December 15, 1992, the Uganda Democratic Coalition (UDC) participated in a demonstration at the Ugandan Embassy in Washington D.C. The demonstration was organized by Amnesty International, commemorating the 44th anniversary of Human Rights Day. UDC issued a new condemnation of the NRM regime for human and civil rights violations, political repression, outrageous corruption and plundering of the Ugandan economy. UDC expressed its resentment for the double standards practiced by some Western governments which support authoritarian and military dictators, such as Museveni, while opposing them with suspension of foreign aid.

UDC also expressed its belief that the World Bank, United States, British and other governments should suspend foreign aid to the NRM government until it fulfills the following demands: (1) UDC demands that the NRM government should stop violating the human and political rights of Ugandans and allow free and fair elections under temporary supervision of the following steps which should be taken immediately by Western governments:

- 1) All international organizations should be immediately suspended. President Museveni should allow the people of Uganda to elect their leaders through free and fair multi-party elections. The process should be supervised and observed by acceptable, impartial and non-partisan organizations.
- 2) The activities of all political parties and restrictions of their activities should be lifted immediately. The people of Uganda have the right to elect their leaders. This political right has been progressively being denied since 1986.
- 3) There are over 8000 political prisoners held in military jails, slabs and other irregular prisons. Many of them have been charged with treason while others have never been charged. Bring them all out. All political prisoners must be released immediately. International and other respectable organizations should be allowed to inspect all prisons, military camps, detention centres, slabs, jails, like Basimba House, and make a full report to be made available to the NRM government to comply with international requirements.
- 4) An independent investigating force must be deployed into

Uganda in order to disarm all rebel groups and Museveni's personal army which is dominated and controlled by Rwandese Tutsis.

5) A national conference of genuine Ugandans from all political parties should be convened in a neutral country, supervised by a reputable and impartial international body.

6) Ugandan opposition leaders and exiles who return home must be guaranteed unconditional security upon arrival so that they may participate fully in their nation's rebuilding.

7) An election date must be set to allow political parties ample time to reorganize themselves adequately. Ugandans will then elect a President, National Parliament, and local Administrative Councils. The newly elected government will be charged with the responsibility of drafting a National Constitution. Only genuine Ugandans will be eligible to participate in the elections.

8) Non-Ugandan insurgency groups now camped and trained in Uganda must be placed under strict supervision of the United Nations and eventual repatriation to their respective countries of origin. This applies to rebel armed groups of Rwandese, Sudanese, Kenyans, Zairians, South Africans, PLOs and others as may be found.

9) An arms embargo should be imposed on Uganda in order to deter further shipment of weapons into the country. It has been proved that all weapons brought into Uganda have been used against the citizens or to destabilize neighboring states. Uganda is not at war nor is it under any external threat, therefore, does not need to stockpile guns which could lead to a situation as that of Somalia.

10) UDC urges all democratic governments to make it a policy not to deal with self-imposed dictators who have not been freely elected by the people of their respective countries.

External Security Organization (ESO) and Internal Security Organization (ISO) are involved in kidnapping, poisoning and assassination of political opponents inside and outside Uganda. Case in point is the murder of Serwan and his associates in Kenya and the poisoning of Sam Sekula in Sweden.

Salim Saleh heads an independent killer squad based in the barracks in Bulungu at Mengo. He is assisted by Capt. Joseph A. Sgt. Swindie and Capt. Joseph Mutebi. They eliminate opponents of the dynasty from within and outside the army. The 2000s Hagan is assistant to Salim have been very instrumental in kidnapping and killing their countrymen. They have targeted, tortured and killed many people in Kampala, Masaka, Mbarara, M. K. M. M. M. Mpigi and other districts. They were specifically established by Museveni to eliminate persons who advocate multi-party democracy, dislike NRM's hold onto power and oppose the state's support for RPF war with Rwanda.

Plundering Uganda's Economy

Tutsis are free to rob Ugandan properties with impunity. For example, vehicles which have been robbed at gun point can be found at bus and other trucks by the hundreds. One of the most notorious thieves is Major Oingo Nyanzi whose stolen mini buses can be found all over Kampala doing taxi work. Tutsis resettlement program, particularly in Buganda, Arko, Toro, Bunyoro has forced natives to their lands to make room for Tutsis moving from refugee camps and those migrating from East and Central Africa. In Mbarara, Kibuka and other counties armed Tutsis led by Ministers and top officials confiscate people's ranches and properties. Special interest programs have been set in various regions of Uganda for Tutsis to enable them to purchase land and to invest in various projects in Uganda.

Uganda's economy has been plundered by the ruling Tutsis and their cronies and surrogates. The exacerbating poverty which has afflicted the country is a result of Museveni's corrupt policies conducted via Tutsi military adventures in Rwanda. The Rwanda Genocide (1994) war is the most costly undertaking for the Ugandan government. The main source of support for NRA/RPF finance, equipment, logistics, trucks, medicine, clothes, food, fuel to military, etc. are siphoned off the NRA budget which is maintained by the government borrowing. This is part of the exorbitant military spending which consumes about 70% of the national budget.

Virtually all parastatal corporations have been packed with Museveni political appointees who have mismanaged, cheated and embezzled state funds. Appointment to most parastatal jobs is based exclusively on tribal origin or on political acceptability within the ruling party camp. Professional competence is least considered. e.g. Ajustina took up the job to manage the Customs and Excise Department. Pigeon and his gang manage the Ministry of Commerce.

Liquid and fixed assets of Uganda Co-op. Transport Corp. were plundered by tribal appointees. Uganda Commercial Bank is bankrupt due to a huge portfolio of unpayable soft loans which were granted to Tutsis and their surrogates in order to buy an economic base.

Salim Saleh is also in charge of feeding the RPF soldiers. The corn flour factory located at Luzira, which was given to him by Museveni, feeds RPF at the expense of NRA. The entire production is purchased by the Defence Ministry to feed Ugandan soldiers but NRA trucks regularly transport the flour to RPF camps located in Rwanda and Uganda. The entire factory personnel are Tutsi soldiers disguised in khaki factory clothes. General Salim Saleh travels to RPF camps inside Rwanda twice a week via NRA helicopter to boost the morale of their soldiers. General Salim Saleh was allocated the former Uganda Blankets Co. and Uganda Sacks Suitcase industry. The entire production supports only RPF needs.

The entire production of Mukisa Biscuit at Kawempe is purchased by the Defence Ministry under the guise of feeding NRA soldiers, but ends up in RPF camps. Bata Shoe Co. was bankrupted when all of its products were taken by RPF, while Ugandan soldiers walk bare-footed.

Recently, RPF supporters held a strategy conference in the main hall at Makerere University. The RPF war with Rwanda would stop if Museveni is removed from power.

Dr. Kato Accused Tutsis Of Killing Ugandans:

Ugandan soldiers have confirmed that accusation. From the days of the bush war till now, Museveni ordered his tribesmen to kill non-supporter Ugandans by hitting on the head with a hoe, a style termed "obufuuni". At Nakasero, Basiima, Makindye, Gaba and other detention centers, only Tutsis operate the murder chambers where thousands of Ugandans have met their painful torture and death. Among the most notorious executioners at Nakasero have been David Kasura, Muyimba, Kuviringira with Muhwezi as the boss. A few years ago, Katsigazi and his squad cleaned the prisons by killing all inmates. When his activities became known to the public, he was merely transferred to the NRM Secretariat which is a part of the spying network. At Luzira Prison, Tutsis carry out torturing of innocent Ugandans.

The so-called "prison medical department" employs only Tutsis who administer poisoning of detainees including injecting them with HIV contaminated materials. One former prisoner injected with AIDS is Lt. James Luwalira. The prison medical department is run by the following Tutsis: Byarugaba, Ms. Mbabazi and Ms. Namakula, Lt. Charles Kweziira, Lt. William Muhamanya, Lt. Charles Kivizera, Lt. Willy Wolere, Lt. Twah Kangave, Sgt. John Galabuzi, Sgt. Joseph Ddungu, Sgt. Alex Bashaija, Sgt. John Mugabo, Gideon Toto, Capt. Samuel Byaruhanga now Deputy Operation Commander in RPF inside Rwanda. Kweziira and Niwamanya are the specialists in injecting HIV contaminations to Museveni's political opponents at Luzira. Many Ugandans have died right after being released from prison where they got injected with either AIDS virus or special slow killing poison which was

acquired from Cuba and East Germany. Those who survive the torture end up with permanent physical and psychological deformations.

Ugandans who are deemed capable of challenging the Tutsi sinister plans are labeled "ekipingamiizi" meaning "one who is against the progress of Museveni and his people" subject to instant elimination. For example, Commander Ahamad Sseguya, Commander Kaggwa and Commander Magara Galibo were killed by Mucunguzi, Kamwanamwana and Simba. Mucunguzi was later posted as chief security officer at Coffee Marketing Board. Major Proof Magala was poisoned. Commander Mugabi, Commander Rubereza were killed. Major Magala Nkubajja was shot at Makindye. Lt. Busagwa was shot at his home at Bayita. (This is the man who used to transport Museveni in a canoe on Lake Victoria during the war.) Major Kawesi and Capt. Yahaya were killed in planned car accidents by Tutsis. Major Matovu, Major Bbosa and Lt. Jimmy Kizito were shot by Tutsis. Maj. Kiiza, Lt. Col. Kirama, Maj. Frank Kibuuka, Maj. Orwoli, Capt. Namiti, Capt. Ssewanyana, Capt. Ben Kiwanuka, Lt. Faluku Kikubali, Lt. Gguma, 2 Lt. Ssendijja were killed in prison. Around 260 soldiers (all Baganda) who belonged to the 34th and 39th battalions were all shot in Eastern Uganda. Hundreds of native Ugandan soldiers have defected. Bernard Buzabo was killed in a planned "car accident".

The Shariat newspaper of December 1st and 15th reported that some Ugandan soldiers have been detained for one to two years at Makindye barracks without trial. They are held in underground cells for more than a year, tortured daily, underfed and are in deteriorating health. Among the names Shariat revealed are: Private Samuel Mweru, Lt. Ahmada Kamya, Capt. Mugumya Magulumaali, Major Musana, Capt. Matic, Capt. Serbowa, Lt. Isaac Ssebulimie, Capt. Kibuuka, Lt. Elly Kigozi, Sgt. Kirumira, Lt. Walusimbi, Major Musana, Sgt. John Wamala, Lt. Grace Magumba, Major Ali Chama, Capt. Okum, Lt. Eddie Kaddy, just to mention a few. Some detainees are not allowed to see their relatives. Torturing Ugandans is conducted by Sgt. Francis Mwongole and Capt. Lweyibanda, according to the Shariat. The Shariat reveals that 50 more Ugandan NRA soldiers were arrested and taken to Makindye underground cells. But NRA fabricated a story that stated those soldiers were taken to Nabisoljo re-organization camp for politicization program but later escaped. It is believed they were all murdered.

These are some of the **CRIMINAL INJUSTICES** which Dr. Kato and others are challenging. Supporting a brutal and evil system like Museveni's, and conniving with Tutsi invaders are acts of treason.

As Ugandans, you should then start working for the release of the slave and stop saving your country from this program.

UDC Newsletter requests all **UGANDAN RELIGIOUS LEADERS** to visit Basilio House, Makindye, Kibira, Gaba, Luzira prison, Argeria House and other detention centers to verify the authenticity of the crimes committed against Ugandans by Tutsi refugees which Dr. Kato has revealed and also reported in this Newsletter. We request that you reveal your findings to the public inside and outside Uganda. For goodness sake, visit Makindye and other government hospitals and see the medical care of your countrymen and women there in. Visit government institutions and see how Ugandans are treated by Tutsi refugees. Visit within your own parishes and dioceses and ask how many have been killed, detained and tortured? Among your congregations ask how many parents can no longer afford to send their children to school or schools and see whose children are at risk.

According to the Scriptures, God does not reward those who are on the side of the oppressed rather than that of the oppressor. On which side are Ugandan religious leaders?

Dr. Kato is a national hero and a patriot. He is a true Ugandan nationalist and is opposed to the Tutsi program. They demand self-determination, respect for their national sovereignty and are opposed to foreign domination with no regard for or concern for Uganda must be ruled by Ugandans. He is a true nationalist. Dr. Kato, that will be one more nation that will not let go the resolve to regain Uganda from the Tutsi. ARM GOVERNMENT HIRES LOBBYIST: The law firm of Patton, Boggs & Blow, P.A. in Washington, D.C. has been hired by the NRA Government to lobby for its interests in America. The lobbyists will try to persuade the U.S. Congress to favor Museveni's executive regime and promote U.S. investment in Uganda. In particular, the American lawyers shall provide legal advice and representation to Uganda Government before the U.S. Congress, Administration and Federal Agencies as may be required. Some of the lawyer's activities will be political. This will include efforts to test the formulation of Congressional policies regarding foreign relations to Uganda and the formulation of U.S. government policies, export financing and foreign military sales programs. Uganda government shall be paying the lobbyists fees based on an hourly rate of \$1,400. A down-payment of \$400,000 is to be paid before March of 1992, at which time the lobbyists and Uganda government representatives will meet to determine the scope of work and fees thereafter for the ensuing year.

...Mr. Joseph L. Brand and Mr. Lansing B. Coe III representing PATTON, BOGGS & BLOW travelled to Uganda in September of 1992, after the Orlando TOW missile smuggling scandal was exposed, met with President Museveni in Gulu and Kampala on September 9, and 11, 1992 after which the American lobbyists flew home with nearly a half a million dollars in their pocket. On September 16, 1992, Mr. A.K. Mayanja, the Uganda Attorney General and Minister of Justice wrote to the American lawyer, stating he is directed to confirm the deal with ...

...PATTON BOGGS & BLOW has "managed" the Uganda side in the "TOW missile smuggling scandal". They were represented with an Orlando astute lawyer, Robert Leverette, who represented Museveni's special aide, Bisangwa Mbugu. As a result of intensive negotiations and maneuvers, the U.S. government dropped charges against Bisangwa Mbugu. However, Bisangwa is now a U.S. government witness in the case

against the other non-Ugandan Museveni's agents with whom he had been arrested last August.

It is a very unfortunate situation to see Uganda spending \$400,000 on American lobbyists within a short time when there is no medicine in government hospitals. It reveals that some American businessmen have championed in creating and nurturing conditions which enhance robbery and corruption in Third World countries such as Uganda. It is inconceivable that an American President could consummate a commercial deal the way those Americans trailed Museveni in Gulu and Kampala. Behind every African dictator, there are found several Western dissolute businessmen busy conjuring loopholes in an attempt to distort cosmetically the ugly reputation of their despot clients for pecuniary gains. After the O.P.I.C. team visited Uganda last summer during which time they reportedly signed various business deals with Museveni, they returned home praising the dictator and calling him "the golden boy of East Africa." Coincidentally, the new U.S. Secretary of Commerce, Ron Brown, has been a partner in the firm of Patton, Boggs & Blow.

(NB: In 1977/78 GENERAL FOOD INC., the largest buyer of Ugandan coffee, hired a powerful lobbyist for \$250,000 to block the Bill in Congress which called for boycotting trade between Uganda and the United States, but a determined group of Ugandans led by Mr. Kintu, won the battle. U.S. Congress passed the legislation suspending diplomatic relations and boycotting trade with Amin's murderous regime.) Right is might. ☐

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
